

Announcement: Peirce Secondary School Secondary 1 posting and registration matters

19 December 2025

Dear **Secondary One**,

Congratulations on completing PSLE and your primary school journey!

And a very warm **Welcome to our Peirce Family!**

Please note that students do not need to report to their posted secondary schools upon receiving their S1 posting results. However, there will be school personnels (Year Heads, School Counsellor, and Special Needs Education Officer) in school on 19 December, Thursday, from 9am to 12pm, if you wish to speak to any of them. Please enter the school via the front gate as construction works are ongoing at the back gate.

The school will be using **Parents Gateway (PG)** to communicate useful information with you on how to prepare your child/ward for the first day of school.

1. Medical Appeal Exercise (MAE)

For MAE, transfer appeals will **only** be considered on exceptional basis for students with:

- Serious medical conditions, such as chronic heart conditions or kidney problems.

All appeals must be accompanied by relevant supporting documents, such as medical reports, letters from doctors etc. They should be submitted to Peirce Secondary School General Office **before 12 noon on 22 December 2025**. The staff will help to file your appeal. The appeal results will be released in early January. In the interim, students should still attend school from 2 Jan 2026. Please call the school at 64576454 for clarifications.

Registration

All parents are to register their child via Parent Gateway (PG), even if they wish to transfer their child out for non-medical reasons. Students seeking transfers should continue to attend their posted secondary school until the transfer is approved. Transfers are subjected to vacancies at the requested transfer school.

Registration is to be done **online**.

For online registration, parents/ guardians must respond to the PG welcome notification by clicking “online registration” and filling up the student profile form on Form@SG by **22 December 2025, 12 noon**.

2. Secondary One student from other schools appealing to Peirce Secondary School (Non-Medical reason)

Primary 6 students who have just received their secondary school posting in 2025 may use this form in the following link: <https://go.gov.sg/appeal-in-2025> to appeal for transfer to Peirce Secondary School. Their PSLE score must meet the school's cut-off point of the posting year.

Transfer will be subject to available vacancies and the school's admission criteria.

Notes:

- (1) The personal information provided in this form will be solely used for the purpose of appealing for secondary school transfer based on non-medical reasons. For appeals based on medical reasons (serious medical conditions or severe physical impairments), please request through the posted school before 12pm on the next working day after the release of the S1 Posting result.
- (2) The deadline for the submission of appeals is on **26 December 2025, 10 am**. Late submission will not be entertained.
- (3) Schools do not disclose reasons for selection / non-selection of students.
- (4) Students should still report to the posted secondary school on 2 January 2026.
- (5) The application is deemed to be unsuccessful if you do not hear from the school by 2 January 2026.

3. Full Subject Based Banding (FSBB)

Full Subject-Based Banding (Full SBB) will be implemented in secondary schools from 2024. For English Language, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics and/or Science, students can take them at the start of Secondary 1 at a more demanding level based on your PSLE AL for the subject.

The eligibility criteria for offering of subjects at a more demanding level:

To take <u>English Language, Mathematics, Science, Mother Tongue Languages at G2/G3</u>		
PSLE Standard grade	PSLE Foundation grade	Option to offer subject at

AL 5 or better	-	G3
AL 5 or better	-	G2 / G3
AL 6	AL A	G2

Eligible students will be given letters of offer via Parent Gateway (PG) or email.

Parent/ Guardian, together with the student, must decide on whether to take up the offer by **26 December 2025, 10 am.**

To take up the offer, parents/ guardians can choose to:

- (1) reply the PG notification
- (2) send an email with signed form (PDF) to Ms June Yeo at yeo_yah_hwee_june@moe.edu.sg

If parents/ guardians do not respond by **26 December 2025, 10 am**, the school understands that the student **will not take up the offer** and the decision is final. Also, please **buy the books** only **after the decision is made**. There will also be insertions at the end of Sec 1 Semester 1 (Mid-Year) and Semester 2 (End of year). Eligible students will be invited.

4. Higher Mother Tongue (Chinese Language)

Students who are eligible to study Higher Mother Tongue Languages (HMTL) will receive an option form. **Eligibility Criteria:**

- An overall PSLE Score of AL 8 or better or
- An overall PSLE Score of AL 9 to 14 (inclusive);
- and attain AL 1/AL 2 in Mother Tongue Language; or
- Distinction/Merit in Higher Mother Tongue Language)

Higher Chinese lessons will be conducted at Peirce. Other HMTL will be conducted outside curriculum hours at MOE designated centres. This form must be completed and submitted to us by Thursday, 5 Jan at the General Office. 6. Reporting time and venue on first day of school on Friday, 2 Jan 2026

Students should report on 2 January 2025, Friday by 7:30 am at the Parade Square in full school uniform. In the event of wet weather, students will gather in the Performance Theatre (PT). Our

student leaders will bring them to the Hall to meet their Form Teachers, to be welcomed by the school population, followed by the flag-raising ceremony. Students need not bring textbooks on the first day of school. They should bring PE attire, stationery, a book to read, a water bottle, and money for recess. As there will not be any special activity to engage parents/ guardians, parents/ guardians need not stay after sending the students to school.
