INFORMATION BOOKLET for Secondary 3 Normal (Academic) Course 2025

GENERAL INFORMATION

This booklet provides information on the various elective subjects available for Sec 3 Normal (Academic) in 2025. It enables parents to make informed choices about their children's subject options for Sec 3 based on academic inclinations, strengths, [interests](#) and aptitudes.

1. Subject Options Exercise is conducted after the release of the year-end examination results.
2. Students will be provided an opportunity to indicate their interest of subject combination in Term 2.
3. Students will be briefed on the subject combination one more time in Term 4.
4. Students will be allocated their subject combinations based on [their Sec 2 Overall results](#).

Instructions on filling up of Subject Options Exercise Form

1. The students will each receive a hardcopy option form to plan for their selection.
2. The students will be given a link to "All Ears" Form, which they need to login using their NRIC number.
3. The students are to rank the order (first to third choice) from a given list of subject combination.
4. Multiple submissions are allowed. Only the last submission will be captured by the system.
5. Students who are **eligible for out-of-stream subject(s)** will be given a hardcopy form for them to indicate whether they would be taking the subjects. They are to return the form within 2 working days.
6. Students applying to take out-of-stream subject(s) are to submit the forms to the General Office by the given deadline. Only forms that are endorsed by a parent / guardian can be considered.

- Hardcopy of the information booklet will be given to all students in Term 2.

Subject Combinations



Normal Academic

6 Subject Combination:

Compulsory subjects	Elective (Choose 1)
EL + MT + 1 Sci + 1 Ma + 1 Humanities	D&T / NFS / Art / Add. Math/ POA

Normal academic students may be offered **out-of-stream*** if they meet the minimum criteria for the subject.

* **EL, MTL, MATH, SCI(PHY/CHEM), Comb. Humanities (SS/Hist), Comb. Humanities (SS/Geog), D&T, NFS, Art**

Additional Mathematics (N-Level)

Sec 2 Normal (Academic) students may be offered **Additional Math @ 'N' Level** if they attain:

- Grade 1 in their 2A Math overall result

OR

- **C5** or better in their 2E Math overall result

Minimum Criteria to be offered out-of-stream



Subjects	Minimum Requirement
EL / MTL / Math / Sci(Phy/Chem) / *Comb Humanities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• SBB students need to obtain an overall results of C6 or better for the respective subjects.• Non-SBB students need to obtain an overall Grade 2 for the respective subjects. <p>*For Humanities, they will also need to attain Grade 2 for EL.</p>
D&T/ NFS/ Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students need to obtain an overall Grade 4 for the respective subjects.

School Policies on the Exercise



Subject Allocation Committee will try to allocate the students their requests as much as possible based on Order of Choice, Merit (but this is subjected to our resource availability).

◆ Appeals

- ❖ All appeals will be looked into only **after** the exercise has been completed based on standing policies;
- ❖ To be made using **official appeal forms** from GO and submitted by deadline
- ❖ Addressed on a case-by-case basis
- ❖ Appeal results will be confirmed and **made known by end of November**

The Appeal Process

All Appeals are to be made during the stipulated appeal period.

The School's decisions made after the release of the appeal results are final.

Once the subject allocation is finalised, the school will not be able to accede to further appeal request.

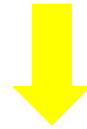
