#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

This booklet provides details to help parents and students make informed decisions about the subjects to read in Secondary 3 Express in 2025.

- 1. Subject Options Exercise is conducted after the release of the year-end examination results.
- 2. Students will be provided an opportunity to indicate their interest of subject combination in Term 2.
- 3. Students will be briefed on the subject combination one more time in Term 4.
- 4. Students will be allocated their subject combinations based on their Sec 2 Overall results.

#### Instructions on Online Subject Options Exercise

- 1. The students will each receive a hardcopy option form to plan for their selection.
- 2. The students will be given a link to "All Ears" Form, which they need to login using their NRIC number.
- 3. The students are to rank the order (first to third choice) from a given list of subject combinations.
- 4. Multiple submissions are allowed. Only the last submission will be captured by the system.

 Hardcopy of the information booklet will be given to all students in Term 2.



## Computing

- Express students may opt to do <u>Computing</u> if they have obtained a grade of B4 or better in Mathematics.
  - 2 parts to 'O' level examination;
  - Paper 1 : Written Paper
  - Paper 2 : Lab based

#### **Post-Secondary Option:**

- GCE 'A' Level Computing at JC
- Variety of courses in polytechnics such as Aerospace Engineering and Health Sciences related
- Enhance chances of being selected in Early Admission Exercise(EAE) by School of IT in polytechnics

# **School Policies on the Exercise**

Subject Allocation Committee will try to allocate the students their requests as much as possible based on Order of Choice, Merit (but this is subjected to our resource availability).

## Appeals

- All appeals will be looked into only <u>after</u> the exercise has been completed based on standing policies;
- To be made using <u>official appeal forms</u> from GO and submitted by deadline
- Addressed on a case-by-case basis
- Appeal results will be confirmed and <u>made known</u> <u>by end of November</u>

## **The Appeal Process**

All Appeals are to be made during the stipulated appeal period.

The School's decisions made after the release of the appeal results are final.

Once the subject allocation is finalised, the school will not be able to accede to further appeal request.


