- 1. Subject Options Exercise is conducted after the release of the end-of-year examination results.
- Students who are eligible for out-of-stream subject(s) will be given a hardcopy form for them to indicate whether they would be taking the subjects. They are to return the form within 2 working days.
- Students applying to take out-of-stream subject(s) are to submit the forms to the General Office by the given deadline. Only forms that are endorsed by a parent / guardian can be considered.
- 4. Students will be provided an opportunity to indicate their interest of subject combination in Term 2.
- 5. Students will be briefed on the subject combination one more time in Term 4.


# Minimum Criteria to be offered out-of-stream



Subjects	Minimum Requirement
EL / Math / Sci(Phy/Chem)	<ul> <li>SBB students need to obtain an overall results of 50% or better for the respective subjects.</li> <li>Non-SBB students need to obtain an overall Grade 1 for the respective subjects.</li> </ul>
D&T (NA)	Grade 2 in Sec 2 Design & Technology
Humanities SS History/ Geography (NA)	<ul> <li>Distinction for SS NT &amp; Grade 1 in English, with teacher's recommendation</li> </ul>





## School Policies on the Exercise



Subject Allocation Committee will try to allocate the students their requests as much as possible based on Order of Choice, Merit (but this is subjected to our resource availability).

#### Appeals

- All appeals will be looked into only <u>after</u> the exercise has been completed based on standing policies;
- To be made using <u>official appeal forms</u> from GO and submitted by deadline
- Addressed on a case-by-case basis
- Appeal results will be confirmed and <u>made known</u> <u>by end of November</u>

## The Appeal Process

All Appeals are to be made during the stipulated appeal period.

The School's decisions made after the release of the appeal results are final.

Once the subject allocation is finalised, the school will not be able to accede to further appeal request.

### Retail Operations (NEW)

#### At 'NT' Level:

Paper 1: Written Exam (1h) - 30%;

Paper 2: Practical Exam (30 mins) - 30%

Paper 3: Practical Exam (15 mins) – 40%

#### Subject Relevance for Post-Secondary Courses

Retail Operations provides foundational knowledge for students opting for Retail-related Courses. Students may choose to enroll to do a 2-year full-time NITEC Retail Services Course in one of the ITEs.

# Promotion Criteria for Secondary 2 Normal (Technical)



#### MINIMUM ATTAINMENT LEVEL

Pass 2 subjects, of which 1 must be English or Maths



70% or higher for all of the following

- a. Average score of all subjects
- b. English
- c. Maths
- d. Science

Eligible for consideration in lateral transfer to Sec 2NA



Promoted to Sec 3NT

#### **NOT MET**

Retained at Sec 2NT
